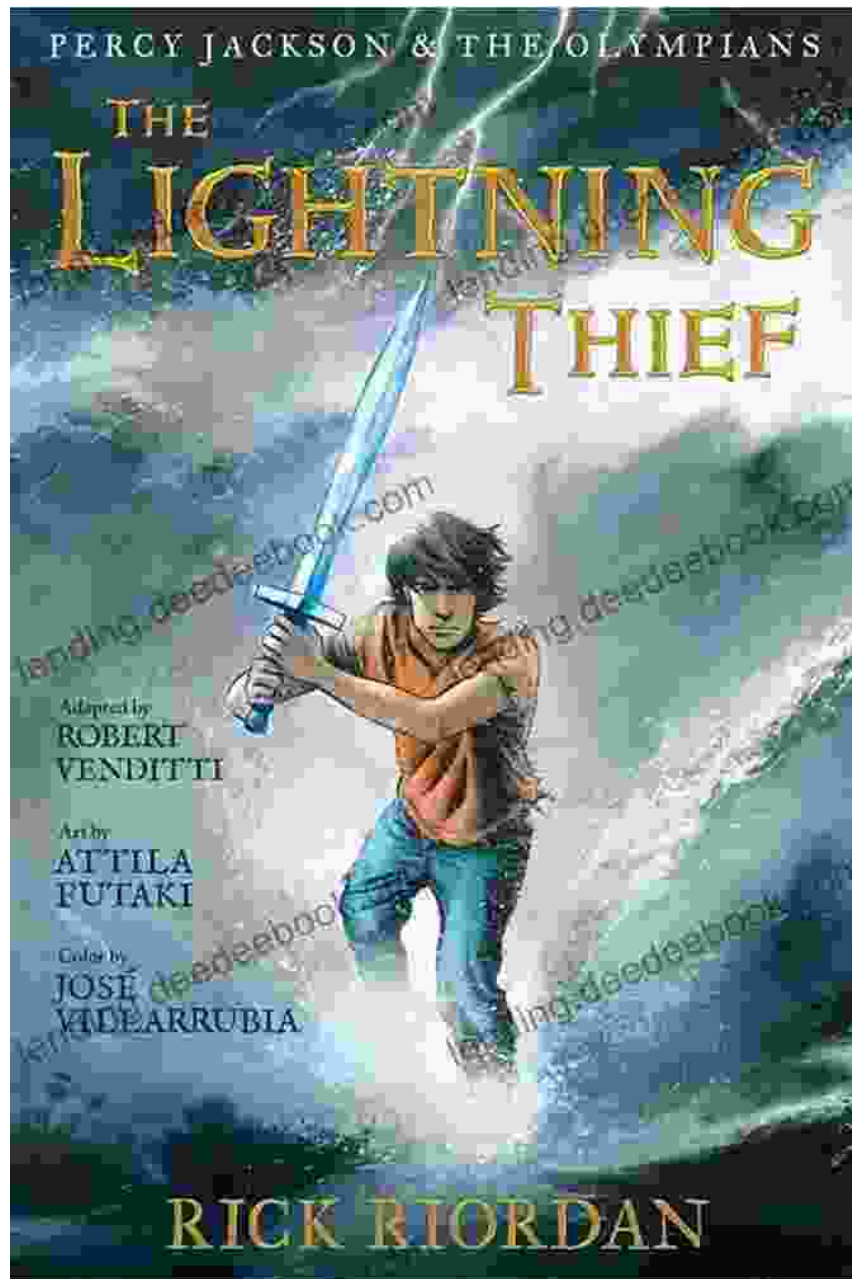


- **Out of the Dust by Karen Hesse**

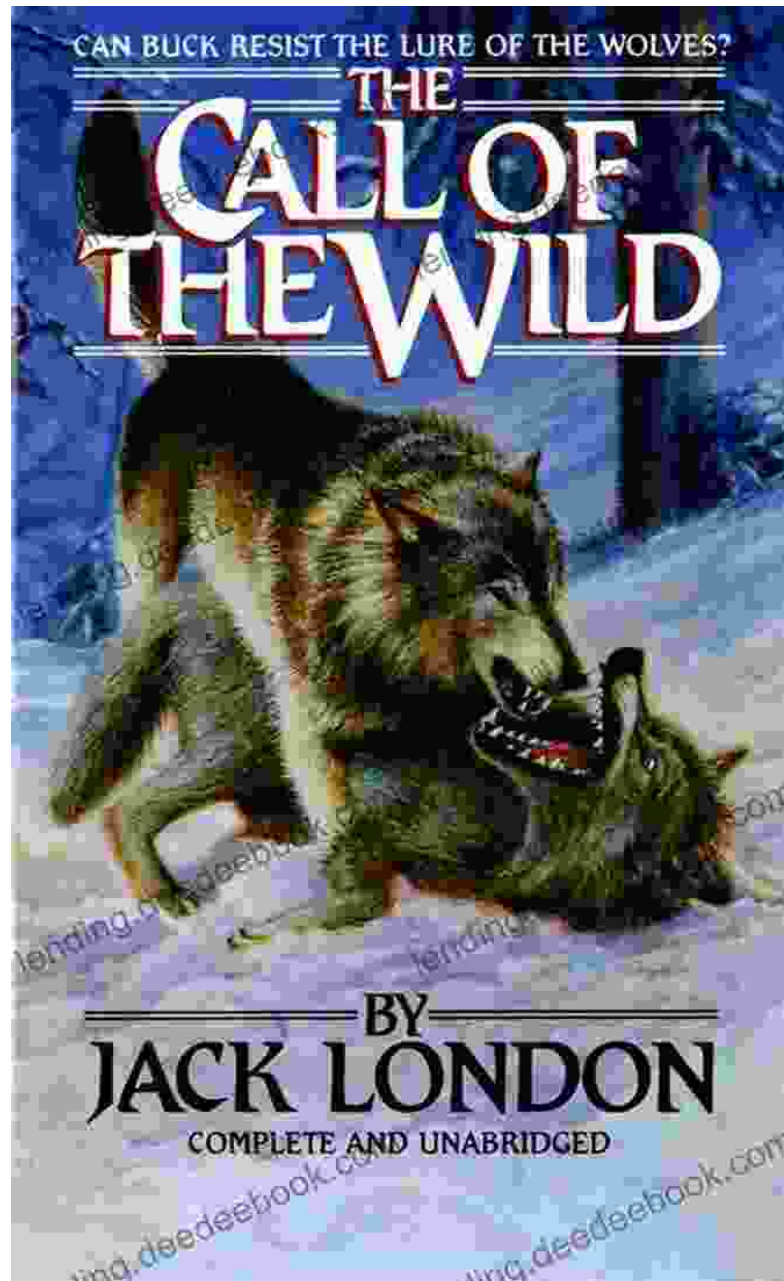
Thrilling Adventures for the Young Explorers

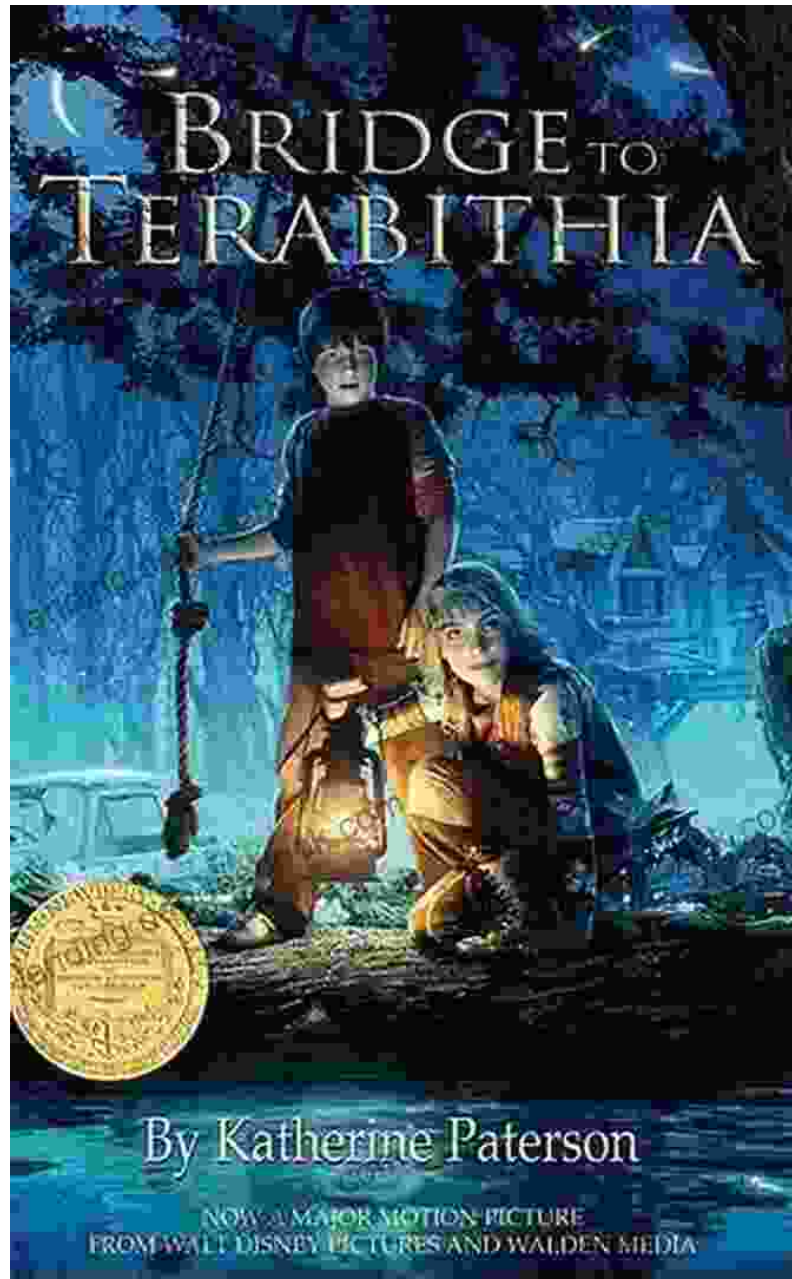


- **The Call of the Wild by Jack London**

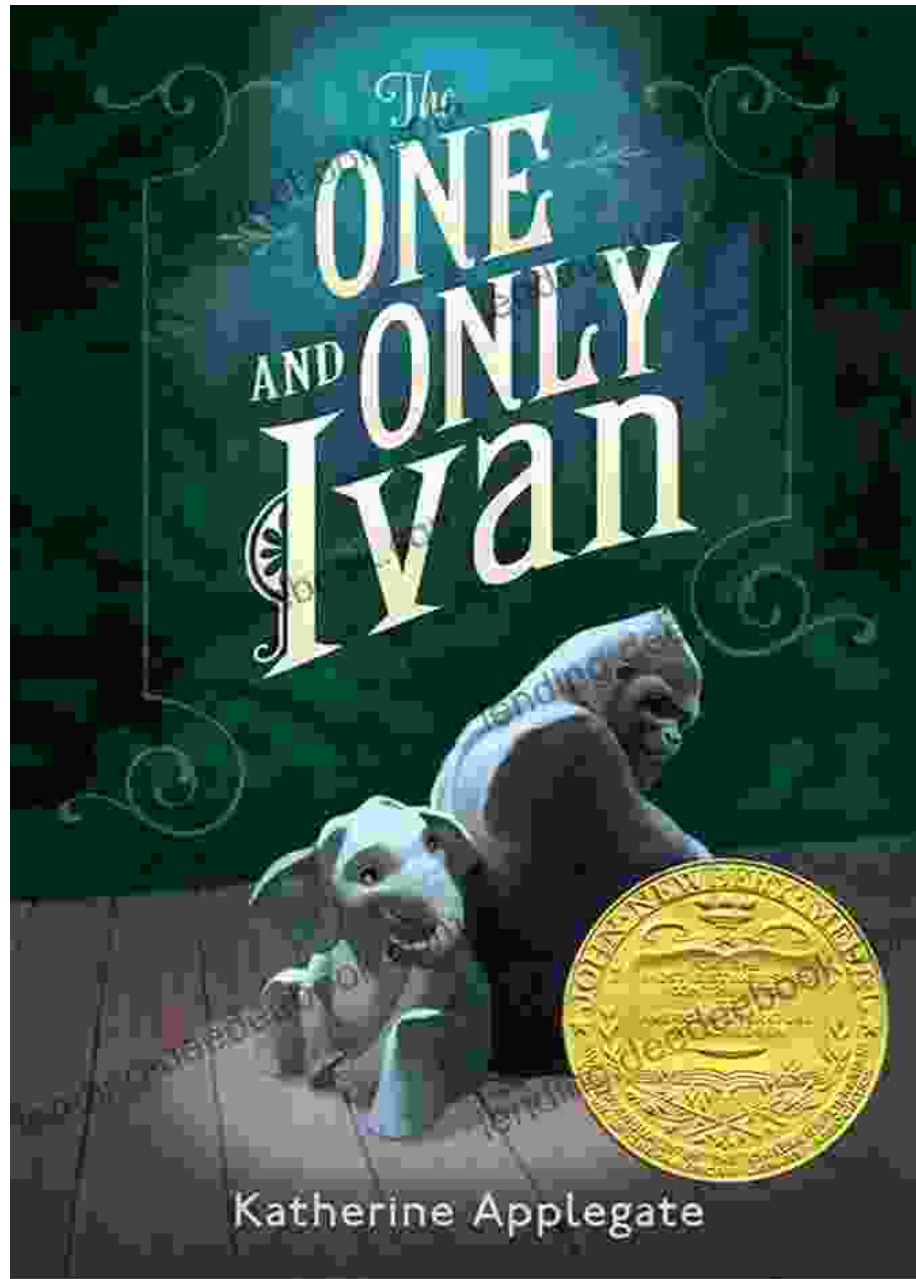
Inspiring Tales for Growing Minds

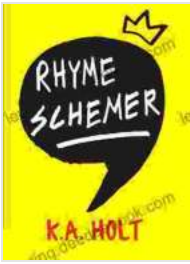

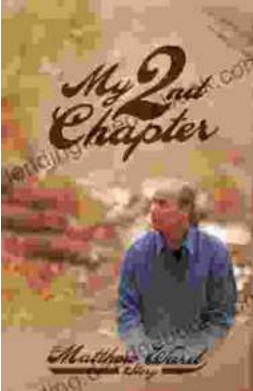

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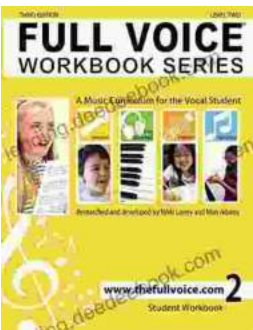
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
