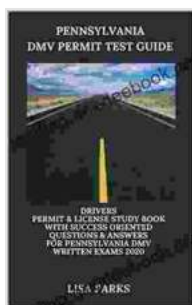

Test Day

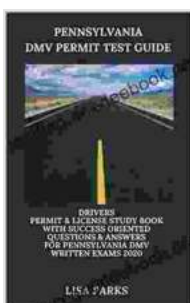
On the day of your test, be sure to arrive at the DMV early. You will need to bring your driver's manual, a form of identification, and the fee for the test. You will also need to take a vision test.

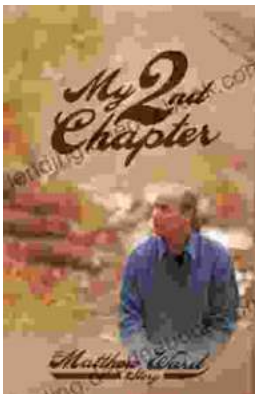

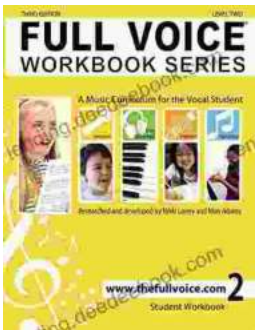
